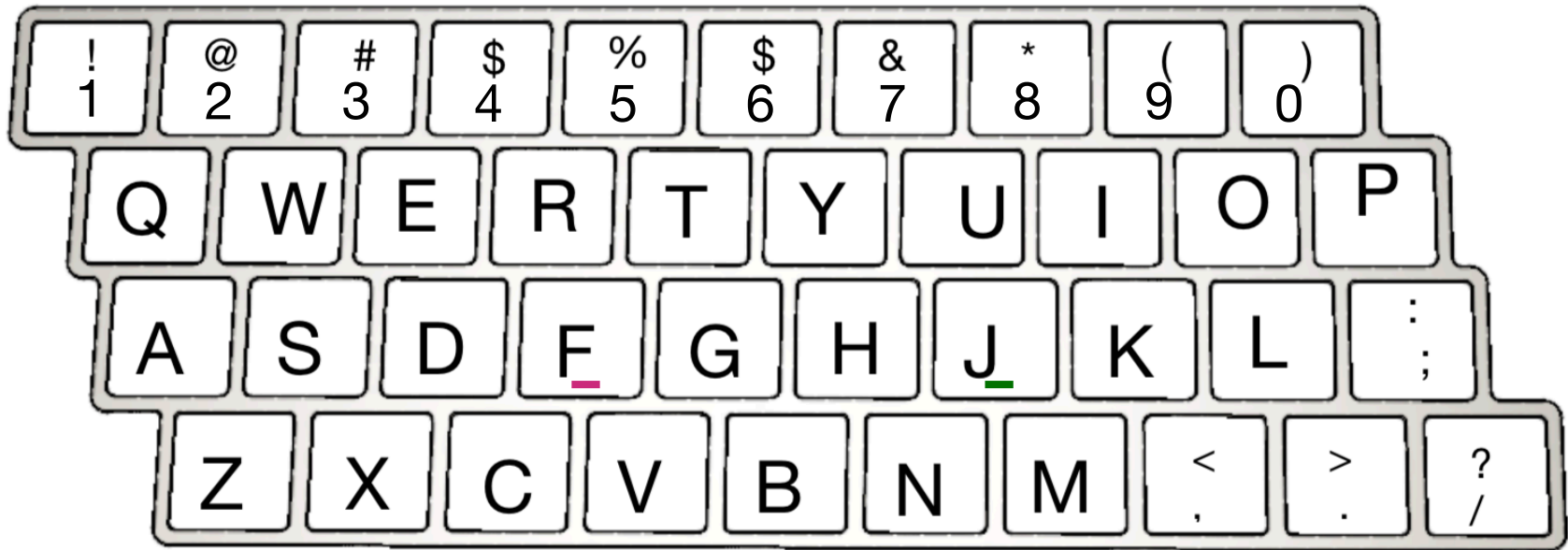

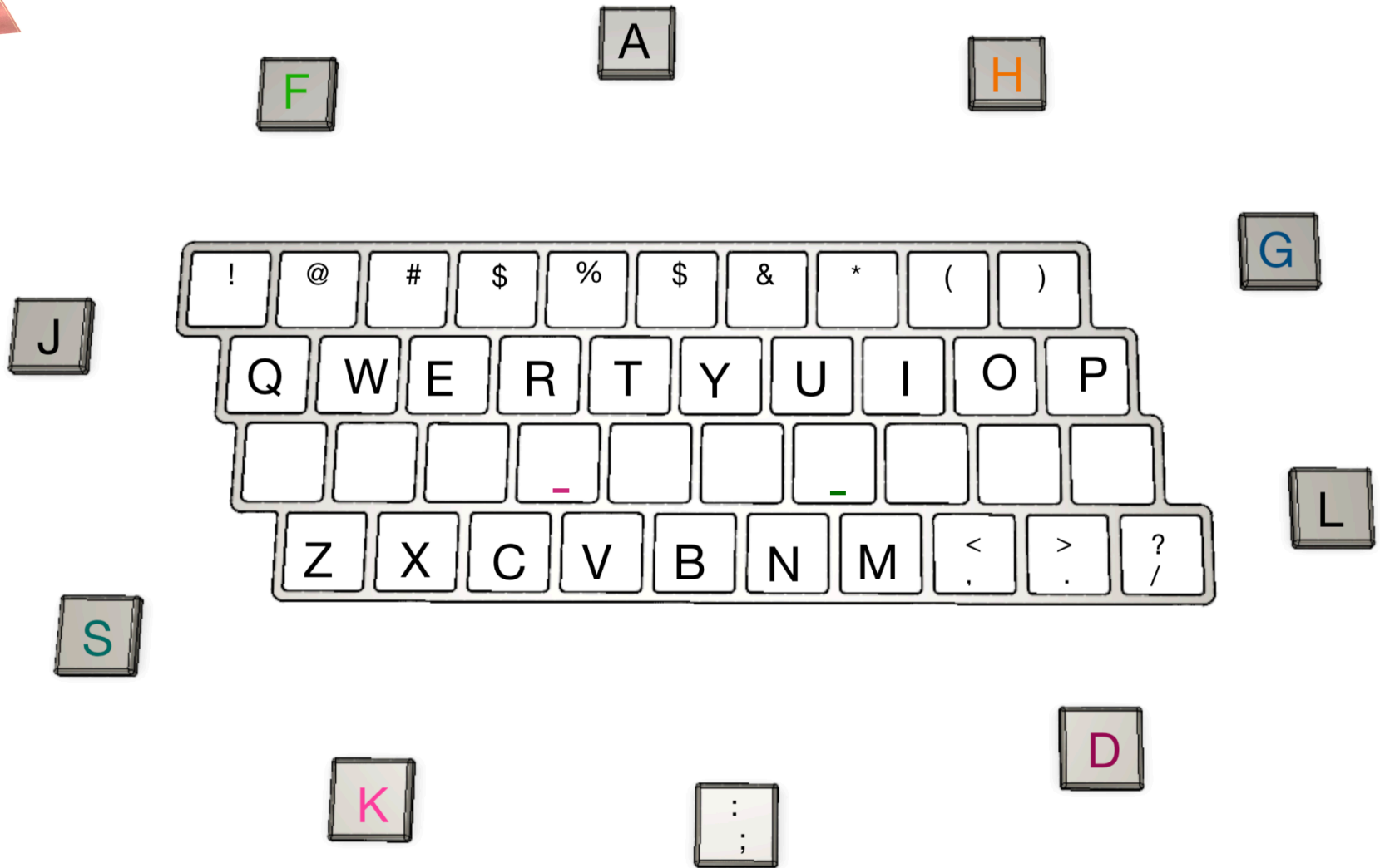
# 1 - QWERTY - row
